Tuition Policy

Tuition is due on the 1st of every month, and is late after the 5th of the month. A \$10.00 late fee is automatically charged on the 6th of the month to all accounts with outstanding balances. Tuition remains the same each month regardless of the number of weeks in the month. Prices cannot be prorated. Please write the student's name on all checks.

Checks should be made out to Baker Performance Academy (BPA).

Enrollment includes 9 months of continued class instruction. If a student must withdraw from class, please notify us in writing. Tuition will continue to accrue until written notice is received. Students may not drop one month and pick back up the next month.

Your \$25 non-refundable family enrollment fee, material fee (if applicable), and your first month's tuition must accompany this form to complete your child's enrollment.

Dress Code

Cinderella Ballet/Tap & Primary Ballet/Tap Classes:

Pink or black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, & black tap shoes.

Ballet/Tap I:

Black leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet shoes. Black jazz pants and black jazz/tap shoes.

On the last class of each month students may wear any color leotard during class.

Ballet/Tap II:

Black leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet shoes. Black jazz pants and black jazz/tap shoes.

On the last class of each month students may wear any color leotard during class.

Ballet/Pointe III:

Solid colored leotard, pink or black tights, and pink pointe shoes.

*Hair should be pulled away from the face and put into a bun and secured for all Ballet classes.

Jazz I, II & Primary:

Any solid colored leotard, black jazz pants, and black jazz shoes (slip-on shoes are preferred).

*Hair should be pulled away from the face, off the neck, and secured for tap & jazz classes (It does not need to be in a bun.)

Musical Theatre/Broadway Babies

Students should wear comfortable clothing they can move around in easily and tennis shoes or dance shoes.

**No jewelry should be worn in any class. Students are to wear a cover-up when entering and leaving the studio.
Dance shoes are not to be worn outside.*

Class Descriptions

Ballet/Pointe

These classes study the traditional style of ballet, which stresses techniques and framework developed through centuries of the existence of classical ballet.

Tap

Tap class consists of learning steps "tapped" out rhythmically and audibly with the feet.

Jazz

Jazz dance emphasizes on flexibility and exaggerated movements, while incorporating individual style. In this class students will study a variety of jazz styles including hip-hop and contemporary.

Cinderella Ballet/Tap/Tumbling

Students do a ½ hour of ballet and 15 minutes of tap or tumbling each week. This class teaches the fundamentals of dance. Students will perform 2 dances in the recital.

Primary Ballet/Tap

This class is an extension of the Cinderella Ballet/Tap class. It is designed to help the student prepare for Ballet I and Tap I. Students will perform 2 dances in the recital.

Musical Theatre /Broadway Babies

Students will study singing, dancing, and acting while working on selections from popular Broadway musicals.

Private Lessons

These lessons give the student personal one on one instruction to enhance their dance, voice or acting ability. These lessons are also good in helping a student prepare for an up-coming audition or performance.

Performance Troupes

This is an audition-only Song & Dance Troupe. These students are invited to perform their musical talents throughout the year at various events. Students must also be enrolled in 1 dance class at BPA. There are additional fees other than tuition.

Dance Company

This is an audition-only group. These students compete at a high level several times a year. Students must also be enrolled in ballet/tap and jazz class at BPA. There are additional fees other than tuition.
