Our Dance Workshop provides a week of technical dance training while having fun with your friends in a safe and positive atmosphere. Throughout the week students will take a variety of dance classes while rehearsing for a final performance to be held on the Friday evening of their workshop week at 6:00 p.m. Students will learn essentials of ballet, tap, jazz, hip hop and contemporary dance.

Musical Theatre Camps

These camps expose children to the performing arts in a unique, fun, and educational manner. Students will study singing, dancing, and acting. They will learn "How To's" in auditioning, as well as proper vocal and dance techniques. Students will also study character development as they work on their scenes. Throughout the camp students will be preparing a mini-musical in which family and friends are invited to attend on Friday evening at BPA.

COST- \$125.00

Includes: a folder & cd, a t-shirt, and a program of Friday's performance. There is a \$25 discount when enrolling in more than one camp. (This includes additional family members).

Students should wear comfortable clothing and tennis shoes to camp each day. Snacks (chips, cookies, popcorn, juice, water, cokes...) may be purchased at the studio, or you may send a snack with your child each day. Camps will be held Monday thru Friday 9 a.m.-12:00 p.m. Friday night's performance will be held at 6 p.m. at BPA. Students should wear their camp t-shirt, denim or blue shorts, and tennis shoes with white socks for the performance.

Private Lessons

COST- \$120.00 per month/\$40 per lesson
(30 minute lesson once a week)

These lessons give the student personal one on one instruction to improve their dance, musical theater, voice, or acting ability. These lessons are also good in helping a student prepare for an up-coming audition, pageant, or performance.

Ballet

These classes study the traditional style of ballet, which stresses techniques and framework developed through centuries of the existence of classical ballet.

Tap

This class consists of learning steps "tapped" out rhythmically and audibly with the feet.

Jazz/Hip Hop

Jazz dance class emphasizes on flexibility and exaggerated movements, while incorporating individual style.

Hip-hop is an extension of jazz dance using high energy movements and steps centered around the music of Rap, R&B, & Pop

Contemporary

This style of dance is a combination of ballet, jazz, and modern dance moves while interpreting a story within the music.



DANCE WORKSHOP DRESS CODE

Ages 3-5: Pink or black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes, and tennis shoes.

Ages 6-8: Solid colored leotard, tights, black jazz pants, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes, and black jazz shoes.

Ages 9 & up: Leotard, tights, black jazz pants, pink ballet shoes, black jazz shoes, and black tap shoes.

* Hair should be pulled away from the face, off the neck, and secured (It does not need to be in a bun) for all classes.

**No jewelry should be worn in any class. Students are to wear a cover-up when entering and leaving the studio. Dance shoes are not to be worn outside.*
